

**APPLICATION FOR DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP TO THE 2019 FAMILY LAW SECTION

The Family Law Section of the Florida Bar has one (1) diversity scholarship of \$500.00 for an individual to attend **The Family Law Section Trial Advocacy Workshop at The Tampa Marriott Waterside Hotel & Marina in Tampa, Florida** from July 25-28, 2019. The Family Law Section will waive the registration fee for the Workshop and will reimburse the scholarship recipient up to \$500.00 *after* receipt of proof of payment of travel and hotel expenses. Any and all other expenses over and above the sum of \$500.00 shall be the responsibility of the participant. The participant must attend all meetings and functions at the Trial Advocacy Workshop. Upon receipt of an Award Letter, the participant must register for the Workshop and make his/her own hotel accommodations.
